



RULES OF THE CAMP

§ 1 Check-in and charges

The Reception of St. Bruno Hotel shall be open 24 hours a day unless the information at the reception states otherwise. Guests shall be obliged to fulfil the check-in procedure at the reception desk immediately after arrival at the Camping. Full payment for the stay shall be paid upon arrival. The payment shall be made during office hours of the reception. Guests staying at the Camping are required to accept these Terms and Conditions and put a parking card in a visible place for the entire stay.

§ 2 Check-in/ check-out time

Check in is at 4:00 p.m. on the first day of the stay and check-out is at 12:00 nn on the day of departure. Upon departure, Guests are kindly requested to complete check-out procedure before the designated check-out time. Check-out shall take place during opening hours of the reception.

§ 3 Main gate Camping

Between 10 p.m. – 7 a.m. main entrance gate is closed. Exit and entry to the facility during these hours shall be possible after prior telephone contact with the reception of St. Bruno hotel. Telephone number to a watchman / alarm number is available at the reception desk and at the main gate.

§ 4 Curfew and disturbing the peace

Regardless of the curfew, loud music is not allowed. Animal owners are requested to provide necessary care for their pupils to ensure that they will cause no disturbance by barking, howling etc. Please do not disturb the peace of other tourists at the camping site in any other manner. Curfew starts at 10:00 p.m. and ends at 7:00 a.m.

§ 5 Presence of guests

After entering the Facility guests shall be obliged to notify the reception about their presence, make necessary payments for the stay according to the price list and observe the rules of these Terms and Conditions. Persons who are not checked-in guests of the Facility are not allowed to stay at the area of the Facility after 10:00 p.m.

§ 6 Animal owners shall be obliged to:

- notify the reception about the presence of an animal and pay the charge specified in the price list;
- walk the dogs on a leash and clean up after their pupils;
- assure an adequate level of care in order to guarantee that the animal will cause no disturbance of peace by barking, howling etc.;
- have a valid certificate of vaccination;
- unconditionally comply with the regulations prohibiting the entry of pet animals to the area of beach, playground and food stands;
- have an animal bed – it is forbidden to keep animals on couches, beds, armchairs.

We do not grant our consent for the stay of animals, whose owners fail to follow the above mentioned rules.

§ 7 Impact on environment

Unauthorised lopping off the branches, digging holes, sign-posting, installation of clotheslines, aerials, construction of platforms, roofing, fencing and any other structures etc. shall be forbidden. Furthermore, it is strictly prohibited to use outdoor dish washer stations and showers.

§ 8 Order at the campground

Camping guests are obliged to keep the area of their stay as well as the area of the Facility clean. **Waste shall be disposed only to the designated collection point.** It is forbidden to throw away high volume, electronic or hazardous waste.



§ 9 Campfires, barbecues

Due to the risk of fire, campfires are only allowed at the designated place nearby the Harbour Orangery. Tourist grills are allowed. Please do not use grills at the terraces of the houses due to the risk of fire and contamination. Used charcoal shall be disposed to the containers at waste collection point beside the Restaurant or left at the place designated for a campfire.

§ 10 Vehicular traffic

Vehicles shall be parked in a car park. Please be reminded to minimise vehicular traffic within the premises of the Camping to a minimum. Do not exceed the speed of 5 km/h and observe extreme caution at all times. The car park inside the Camping is unguarded.

§ 11 Gainful activity at the camping site

Carrying out any commercial activity shall be strictly forbidden at the camping site without prior consent of the owner. It shall be strictly prohibited to rent caravans, yachts, campers etc. to third parties or lending them in order to gain material profit. Breach of this provision shall entail immediate expulsion from the Facility.

§ 12 Responsibility for children staying at the premises of the Camping

Children are allowed to stay at the premises of the Camping solely under supervision of their parents or persons directly responsible for them. Children are not allowed to use equipment, playground or any services at the premises of the Camping without the presence of adults responsible for their supervision. The Camping refuses to accept any liability for children staying at the premises of the Camping.

§ 13 Liability for damage

The Guests of the Camping shall be financially responsible for damage done to property, equipment or technical devices at the Facility which resulted from their actions or from the actions of persons who were visiting them.

§ 14 Liability for items left

The Camping shall not be liable for any valuable items left at caravans, campers, yachts, tents or houses. Furthermore, the Camping accepts no responsibility in case the caravan, camper, yacht, tent, car or any other item brought by the Guest is damaged or stolen.

§ 15 Refusal to entry the Camping

The Staff reserves the right to refuse entry to the Camping for people behaving in an improper way or people under the influence of alcohol. The staff has the right to expel people refusing to comply with the regulations of this Terms and Conditions. The Camping may refuse to accommodate a Guest, who had breached the Terms and Conditions during his last stay by causing damage to the property of the Camping or other Guest; or personal injury to other Guest, member of the staff or other persons staying at the Facility; or in other way disturbing the functioning of the Facility or other Guest's peace during their stay.

§ 16 Violation of Terms and Conditions

Staying at the premises of the Facility shall be tantamount to the acknowledgement and acceptance of these Terms and Conditions. The violation of these Terms and Conditions or code of social conduct shall be subject to evaluation of the receptionist, who has the right to terminate the Guest's stay without the possibility of refund for the cost of accommodation.

§ 17 Obligations of Tourist upon check-out

The Tourist upon check-out shall be obliged to:

- check-out from the house or camping before the designated check-out time (Point 2) during the office hours of the reception
- return the key to the house
- leave house and its surrounding or a place of camping tidy and clean
